MINUTES

Regular Meeting BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Vernon College December 14, 2022

The Board of Trustees of Vernon College met on Wednesday, December 14, 2022 at 11:30 a.m. in the *Board Room* of the *Osborne Administration Building*, Vernon, Texas with the following present: Mr. Bob Ferguson – Chairman; Mrs. Ann Wilson – Vice-Chairman, and Mrs. Betsy Smith – Secretary. Chairman Ferguson called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m.

Consent Agenda

Mrs. Wilson made the motion, seconded by Mrs. Heatly to approve the Consent Agenda containing the *Minutes of the November 9, 2022 Regular Board Meeting* and the *President's Monthly Travel Expense Report*. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>Public Comment</u> – No one was present to make comments.

Action Item A

Mrs. Flynn presented the *Financial and Investment Reports as of November 30, 2022*. Mr. Holt made the motion, seconded by Mrs. Wilson, to approve the Vernon College year to date monthly financial and investment reports as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

Action Item B

Mrs. Smith made the motion, seconded by Mrs. Chapman, to approve the 2021-2022 Vernon College Audit prepared by Condley and Company LLP and publically presented by auditors Mr. Graham and Mr. Mayes. The motion carried unanimously.

Action Item C

Mr. Brock made the motion, seconded by Mrs. Wilson, to approve the 2023-2027 Strategic Plan presented by Dr. Beauchamp. The motion carried unanimously.

Action Item D

Ms. Chong with *Crusoe Energy* presented the company's plans to construct an energy data center connected to the Electra Windfarm, in three phases. Crusoe Energy is requesting a tax abatement from Vernon College. Mr. Holt made the motion to approve the Crusoe Energy abatement application. There was not a second motion, so the motion failed. Mr. Holt then made the motion to table for further discussion, Mrs. Smith seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Action Item E

There were no Tax Resale Deeds to present.

<u>President's Report/Board Discussion Items</u> – Dr. Johnston shared with the Board that he has received many "thank you" cards from employees for the \$25 United gift cards given to all full time employees. These gift cards are given in lieu of a company Christmas Party.

<u>Hasanour Investments, LLC (Vernon Travel Center) tax abatement request</u> – Mr. Bob Souweid with Bora Petroleum Inc. made his presentation for discussion requesting approval of a tax abatement. He described the plans to build a travel center on the old Gibson's Discount Center site off Hwy 287. He stated his application has been received from the City of Vernon and Wilbarger County.

<u>TASB 44 review</u> – Dr. Johnston stated the website access has changed requiring new passwords. He will inform the Board as soon as the site is available for review.

Review of 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan Final Summary – Dr. Beauchamp presented the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan Final Summary stating it is a summary of last year's plans. It is listed by priority initiative for each component of the college. It ties in to the budget, time and effort, and used for improvement and planning.

<u>Annual Continuing Education Enrollment Report</u> – Mrs. Drury presented the 2021-2022 Summary for Continuing Education courses funded by the state (funded non-credit) and the CE personal enrichment classes for community service (non-funded, non-credit). She also presented comparison charts by major programs, head count, contact hours, and total enrollment.

Student Success Data Fact – Dr. Donnie Kirk presented a summary of the Fall 2021 Survey of Entering Student Engagement (SENSE) results as the Student Success data fact for this month. The report utilizes a three-year cohort (2019 through 2021) of participating colleges. He stated this survey is administered every other year and is a product and service of the Center for Community College Student Engagement. It helps community colleges discover why some entering students persist and succeed and others do not. There were 174 institutions that participated. Due to COVID, the survey was administered on-line. There were 72 students who reached the end of the survey. The next survey will be administered, in class, in 2023.
