MINUTES

Regular Meeting BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Vernon College November 11, 2020

The Board of Trustees of Vernon College met on Wednesday, November 11, 2020 at 11:30 a.m. in the *Board Room* of the *Osborne Administration Building*, Vernon, Texas with the following present: Dr. Todd Smith – Chairman; Mr. Bob Ferguson – Vice-Chairman and Mrs. Ann Wilson – Secretary. Chairman Smith called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m.

Consent Agenda

<u>Foundation meeting report</u> – Dr. Smith gave an update on the Vernon College Foundation annual board meeting held on October 15, 2020 in the Board Room on the Vernon campus and the Joe Chat Sumner, III Conference room at Century City Center using Microsoft Teams. Re-elected Mrs. Helen Willingham Chair of the Board; Mrs. Joni Streit Vice Chair; and Ms. Sara Jane Snell Secretary/Treasurer. The Foundation matched the proceeds from the 2020 Foundation On-Line Auction. They awarded grants to the following departments:

Dr. Johnston discussed the Fall 2020 Semester Enrollment update, the new Court Reporting program, the Medical Assisting, Dental Assisting, and Barber programs, new hires at Vernon College, the Vernon College Rodeo, the actions taken by the Board of Trustees regarding a tax abatement, the tax rate, and COVID-19. Michelle Alexander presented the annual philanthropic report, and Garry David presented the annual financial report.

<u>Campus opening/COVID-19 Update</u> – Dr. Johnston stated that Dr. Nordone is doing a good job in conjunction with the Health Department on any activity every week for Wichita and Wilbarger counties. Vernon College's approach is for students and staff to quarantine for 14 days immediately after finding out if exposed. Faculty are being flexible and helping students from falling too far behind. The numbers are still less than 1.5% of our student population and staff who have tested positive. We continue to encourage students and staff to take personal and social responsibility while on their own time.

Review of 2019-2020 Institutional Effectiveness Plans Final Summary and the 2019-2020 Annual Action Plan Final Summary – Mrs. Harkey presented the summary of what was accomplished during 2019-2020 for both plans. The structure of both plans show the resources needed, persons' responsible, and statement of need.

Student Success Data Fact – Mrs. Harkey presented the Student Success data fact for this month as the Vernon College Effectiveness Questionnaire results. She stated twice as many people responded compared to last year and went over the percentages of changes in responses. This information is used in the annual planning process, effectiveness plans, and end of the year summaries. The questionnaire data is used by departments as an assessment tool to gather any feedback on any trends, changes or enhancements to be made.
