QEP Snapshot. The Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP) is the central standard of the Commission on College's philosophy of accreditation. Thus, institutions seeking a reaffirmation of accreditation are required to develop a (QEP).

Inquiry-based Learning. The upcoming Quality Enhancement Plan (QEP) for Vernon College proposes the introduction and implementation of student-centered, inquiry-based learning strategies within both academic and CTE programs. Inquiry-based learning describes a learning approach where learning is achieved through research and investigation activities in response to set problems and tasks (Wyatt, 2005).

Key data indicators. Throughout the 7 year QEP process, data collection will primarily be garnered from CCSSE and SENSE surveys, SIIR II and ESCR reports, as well as core assessment results. From such reports, <u>markers indicating the following will be culled</u>:

- Collaborative learning (with peers and instructors)
- Project/presentation-based learning
- Community-based learning
- Professional skill attainment
- Retention/recruitment
- Achievement/success
