

Dear Students,

Can you see yourself in the picture for the summer of 2017? If so, please keep reading below...



Have you ever thought about local missions work as a possible summer job? Would you like to participate in a ministry that helps change the lives of hundreds of youth and children each summer? Then look no further as we have a great work opportunity for you at Camp Chaparral. If you have come to the conclusion that this is where you are supposed to serve please let us know by sending in your application. (Attached below) Phone interviews will be conducted with the top candidates in early March.

The pay is a \$240 (per week worked) Scholarship and a \$50 a week stipend. So \$290 per week worked (minus any taxes) plus summer housing and meals included during camp sessions.

At this time, there will be 8 weeks of work opportunity (scholarship potential \$1,920 + \$400 Stipend = \$2,320 for 8 Weeks (minus any taxes).

We ask that you commit to at least 7 weeks of work with us and mandatory working for the weeks listed below **in bold letters**.

A) Preparation Week May 22 – 27 (we will enlist a smaller work group to help us get ready for our first camp – regular pay)

2) **Orientation Week June 5 – 10**

3) Garland Week June 12 – 17

4) **GA & RA Week June 18 – 24** (this is a long week Sunday through Saturday)

5) **Entrust Student Week June 26 – 30** (this is one of our programmed camps)

B) Kids Fundays July 6-8 (we will need several staffers for a one day - Kids Fundays event) \$100 pay for 3 work days this week only.

6) **Extreme Days Student Week July 10 – 15** (this is one of our programmed camps and our largest camp – all hands on deck)

7) ITZ Camp Week July 17 – 22

8) **Preteen & Kids Camp Week July 23 – 29** (this is a long week Sunday through Saturday – all hands on deck)
