- Video Projects—classes such as biology

- Multimedia Message Boards—these flat screen TV's can be found on all 3 campuses and give important updates from new services available to free lunch!
- Video Tutorials— when working on your next project, visit the Library website to view a video tutorial on how to research using our online databases.
- Facebook-using Facebook in the class-

room, instructors can publish notes and tag students. For example, they can post assignments or notify you of their online office hours.

• Twitter— allows you to follow news, post discussions, updates, communicate with your instructors and classmates, and stay connected with alumni.
