- 2. Dr. Harkey made the motion, seconded by Mrs. Elliott to Approve the Minutes of the February 11, 2013 Meeting as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

- 4. The motion passed unanimously.
- 6. After a review and comparison of the General Admission Policy and Mission Statement. Dr. Harkey made the motion, seconded by Mrs. Raines to agree that current Admissions Policies are consistent with the Mission of Vernon College. The motion passed unanimously.
- 7. A short discussion was held to discuss and review the decision to drop the Application for Admissions fee of \$10. The unanimous hope is that dropping the fee will help students view Vernon College as a more student friendly option to continue their education.
