## Regular Meeting BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Vernon College September 11, 2019

entity has a chance to nominate someone. All nominations from the entities are reviewed for selection. The nomination needs to be turned in by October 15.

<u>Health Care Clinic Annual Report</u> – Dr. Nordone stated that there is not much activity to report. It is a service provided to any Vernon College student. The annual report shows the number of visits made in a twelve-month period to the clinic for such things as minor cuts and bruises, headaches, colds, etc.

Student Success Data Fact - Fall 2019 Enrollment Update

Mrs. Amanda Rains presented a Preliminary Enrollment Report and Comparison for Fall & Fall 1 2018 versus Fall & Fall 1 2019 as the Student Data Fact for September. She stated the official count day is today, September 11, and at the end of the day we will do an official count. Overall, on the total unduplicated for all locations as of right now, we are down 3.5%, but down only .5% in our contact hours. An official final report will be sent to the Board when completed. This report meets with the criteria as our first priority initiative, which is recruiting and retention.
