# **MINUTES**

## Regular Meeting BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Vernon College September 13, 2023

The Board of Trustees of Vernon College met on Wednesday, September 13, 2023 at 11:30 a.m. in the *Board Room* of the *Osborne Administration Building*, Vernon, Texas with the following present: Mr. Bob Ferguson – Chairman; Mrs. Ann Wilson – Vice-Chairman, and Mrs. Betsy Smith – Secretary. Other board members in attendance were Mr. Irl Holt, Mr. James Brock, Mrs. Jamie Chapman and Mrs. Meg Heatly.

Chairman Ferguson called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m.

#### Consent Agenda

Mr. Holt made the motion, seconded by Mrs. Wilson, to approve the Consent Agenda containing the *Minutes of the August 9, 2023 Regular Board Meeting* and the *President's Monthly Travel Expense Report*. The motion carried unanimously.

## Action Item A

Mrs. Flynn presented the *Financial and Investment Reports as of August 31, 2023*. Mr. Brock made the motion, seconded by Mrs. Chapman, to approve the Vernon College year to date and monthly financial and investment reports as presented by the Chief Financial Officer. The motion carried unanimously.

## Action Item B

Mrs. Smith made the motion, seconded by Mrs. Wilson to approve the annual 2022-2023 Wilbarger County Tax Collections for Vernon College by the Wilbarger County Tax Collector, as presented by Dr. Johnston. The motion carried unanimously.

#### Action Item D

No resale of tax foreclosure properties to approve.

<u>President's Report/Board Discussion Items</u> – Dr. Johnston discussed the Board's interest in attending Board of Trustee conferences from the self-reflection exercises back in January. He mentioned the opportunity for upcoming events - CCATT Conference – Fort Worth – September 14-16, 2023 and the THECB Leadership Conference – Austin – December 12-13, 2023.

<u>Department of Ed. Annual Security Report</u> – Chief Kevin Holland presented the Annual Security Report. The normal data collected by Chief Holland was submitted September 7, 2023 to the Department of Education. He stated we are fortunate to not have any incidents to report.

<u>Health Care Clinic update</u> – Mrs. Kristin Harris presented the Health Care Clinic annual report from September 2022 through August 2023. She stated there were 156 total visits over last year, including flu shots given by Family Pharmacy. The clinic is located in the Sumner Applied Arts building on the Vernon campus. Provider Lindsay R. Streit, Family Nurse Practitioner, and LVN, Camry Deleon are doing a wonderful job. Hours for student or staff visits are posted to the Health Clinic Door, but always 2:00 to 4:30 on Wednesday-the day the practitioner is present.

Student Success Data Fact – Ms. Colleen Moore presented the Preliminary Enrollment Report and Comparison for Fall 2022 vs. Fall 2023 as the Student Success Data Fact. She stated the total headcount for all locations went down from 2,251 to 2,146, or a decrease of 4.66% following the state and nationwide trend. Vernon, Skills and Online were up some as well as Dual Credit. Colleague and Poise look at these numbers differently, so the two cannot be compared this year. By next fall, we should be able to compare.

Student Highlight – Mr. Sjohonton Fanner presented Tatyanna Austin as the student highlight for this month. He pointed out her pathway and concentration, accomplishments, challenges and future plans. Tatyanna is a local, a graduate of Northside High School with 18 dual credit hours. After earning her Associate degree in Biology/Pre-Med Concentration from Vernon College, she plans on attending Texas Tech University for a Bachelor of Science in Biology. Then apply to a medical school and pursue a career in Pediatrics.

<u>Tax Abatement Policy discussion</u> – During the last discussion, the Board agreed to develop and implement a tax abatement policy and guidelines. Dr. Johnston opened the discussion saying all members are welcome to comment opinions or concerns. After discussion, the President stated he would come up with a draft of two or three scenarios of abatement standards, based on today's ideas, for Board members to consider.
