Accomplishments:

- Cathy Bolton, MSN, RN retired as program director after 36 years of service to Vernon College.
- Mary Rivard, PhD, RNC-OB assumed responsibilities as Director of Associate Degree Nursing.
- VC NCLEX-RN exam first time pass rate increased to 88.46%
 - o Full approval granted at the Board of Nursing's January meeting
- BON visit (4/29/15): accepted the report on the visit with one requirement: no later than October 1, 2015, the program shall submit to Board Staff copies of nursing course syllabi which reflect microbiology and nutrition objectives and content and a matrix of the program curriculum depicting integrated content; submitted and accepted on 9/17/2015.
- Began offering Legal and Ethical Issues in Nursing course to LVN's not currently in the program.
- Beth Arnold was selected to serve on the Uniform Pre-Nursing Curriculum Advisory Committee for the state of Texas.
- Developing articulation agreements between VC and university BSN programs through joining the CABNET consortium.
- Students will be carrying Competency Transcripts throughout the program to verify competency of listed skills for potential employers.
- Developed the Admission Point System to assist in providing an objective format for selection of students for the program.
- Beginning fall 2016, all ADN students will be required to provide proof of current health insurance coverage.
- A newborn simulator was purchased and has been used in simulation learning activities.
- Began taking students to Promise Hospital and House of Hope for geriatric clinical experiences.
- We will be adopting an online testing format (Examsoft) beginning summer, 2017. All students will be required to have a laptop computer or an IPad to use this service.
- Purchased webcams for all faculty and staff members to allow for online meetings with students and other faculty/staff.

- We continue to offer tutoring sessions (faculty driven and peer driven) for students desiring extra help.
- Faculty are providing mandatory advising to program students at mid-tern and end of term.
