He also reviewed the Fall 2012 enrollment, depicting an average class size of 13.8 and 5 practicums.

Mr. Holcomb stated that the Learner outcomes basically are a contract with the student. Mr. Smith commented they are the key points for instructional areas.				
Program revisions, curriculum/course review – AGAH 1311 Livestock Evaluation I	Mr. Holcomb informed the committee that AGAH 1311 Livestock Evaluation I is being archived from the course listing mandated by the State. Mr. Smith commented that the same course is taught as an academic course, listed as AGRI 2321 Livestock Evaluation I. Shannon Conley questioned the possibility of an AI lab/certification. She will research on the possibility of a palpitation lab, possibly utilizing a local vet clinic for a weeklong session for certification.				
valuation of Facilities, Equipment, and Technology	The Farm and Ranch Management classroom, equipment, and technology are up to date and adequate, explained Mr. Smith. He stated, this department utilizes external labs for hands on experience, instead of simulation type devices in the classroom. Also, the department has purchased DVD's to enhance instruction in the classroom.

These locations are useful to enlighten student knowledge in the work area and broaden the mentality of students leaning toward the Farm and Ranch career choice. He expressed his appreciation for the insight and/or help from committee members assisting our students.
