## **MINUTES**

Old Business:	
AAD Program to Inactive Status	Jeff reported the AAD Program will be officially on Inactive Status as of August 2014. ARC/STSA have been officially notified that Vernon College intends for the program to remain Inactive.
Continuing Business:	
Transition to Associate Degree	Jeff reported to the committee to keep compliant with accreditation standards, VC must offer an associate degree by 2021. Jeff and the committee discussed implementing the degree in the 2015/2016 academic year. The committee entertained the idea of slowly transitioning general education courses into pre-requisite requirements to the program. The committee thought this would help eliminate a drop in enrollment to the program. It was also agreed by the members that the certificate of completion would be phased out as the general education requirements are required. Jeff explained the certificate of completion could not be used after 2021 with the associate degree being the minimum degree awarded for completion of the program. Jeff and Dr. Harkey will proceed with the process of college and state coordinating board approval for the associate degree and report back to the committee in Fall 2014.
New Business:	
Program statistics: Graduates, majors, enrollment	Jeff provided the committee data on the current class and historical data on enrollment. The current class has 9 students after starting with 12. One student dropped before Christmas due to personal reasons and two students dropped in the spring semester. The current class has 3 males and 6 females with two females and one male dropping.  Jeff explained to the committee the information pertaining to the clinical agreement with Dr. Stephan is currently being looked at by the doctor's attorney. He also reported that 12 clinical slots are currently available. The annual report to ARC/STSA is due Thursday, and the program will start taking applications May 1st for the next class.
	Discussion concerning clinical site availability and current employment opportunities was held. Amanda stated they will have one opening at United Regional and Rhonda included there are at least two openings' at Kell West. Jeff reported there is one student currently seeking employment in Louisiana, he has reached out to his colleagues there to help her find a job there locally. He has been maintaining contact with his network for potential employers for the current class in Texas and Oklahoma. He will also seek potential employers while at the AST National Conference. Dr. Harkey stated this would be a good time reach out to Kell West and Electra Hospital for prospective clinical sites.  The committee recommended by mutual consent if additional clinical slots become available for the 2014/2015 academic year the program should return to a maximum enrollment of 15 students.
