I. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Report the approval of the March, April and May 2020 Electronic Meeting Minutes

II. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Automation and Electrical Technology

Mark Holcomb

Mark Holcomb reviewed revisions to the Automation and Electrical Technology Program that include the following:

ELMT 2433 Industrial Electronics- Remove the prerequisite and add the statement:

Capstone course, to be taken with consent of instructor in student’s last semester prior to graduation.

ELPT 1441 Motor Control- Catalog correction: CETT 1402 was removed from the

program in Fall 2018. The correct prerequisite is ELPT 1411 Basic Electrical Theory. ELPT 2419 Programmable Logic Controllers I- Remove the prerequisite from this course. Shana Drury seconded the motion and it passed by majority vote.

- B. Business Management Certificate and Degree Mark Holcomb
At the recommendation of the program's advisory committee, Mark motioned to make the following changes:

- C. Program Addition: Court Reporting Shana Drury

- D. Substantive Change Policy Shana Drury
Committee members reviewed the Substantive Change Policy and Amanda Raines motioned to accept the policy as written. Mark Holcomb seconded the motion and it received majority vote approval from the committee.
