Prerequisite: Concurrently enrolled in EMSP 1501 or consent of instructor. Lab Fee: \$24.00; Special Fees: Program Fee: \$50.00; Fisdap Fee: \$35.00; National Registry Testing Fee: \$80.00; Liability Insurance Fee: \$20.00 (Charged once each academic year)

EMSP 1338 Introduction to Advanced Practice

Prerequisites: Licensed EMT-B; concurrently enrolled in EMSP 1355, EMSP 1356, and EMSP 1362 or consent of instructor. Lab Fee: \$24.00; Special Fees: Program Fee \$50.00; EMS-A testing fee \$60.00

Prerequisites: Licensed EMT-B; concurrently enrolled in EMSP 1338, EMSP 1356, and EMSP 1362 or consent of instructor. Lab Fee: \$24.00; Special Fees: Program Fee \$50.00

EMSP 1356 Patient Assessment and Airway Management

Prerequisites: Licensed EMT-B; concurrently enrolled in EMSP 1338, EMSP 1355, and EMSP 1362 or consent of instructor. Lab Fee: \$24.00; Special Fees: Program Fee \$50.00

EMSP 1362 Clinical-Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic) (A)

Prerequisites: Licensed EMT-B; concurrently enrolled in EMSP 1338, EMSP 1355, and EMSP 1356 or consent of instructor. Lab Fee: \$24.00; Special Fees: Program Fee \$50.00

EMSP 1501 Emergency Medical Technician

Prerequisites: Admission to the EMS Program; concurrently enrolled in EMSP 1260 or consent of instructor. Lab Fee: \$24.00; Special Fees: Program Fee: \$50.00; EMS-B testing fee: \$45.00

Marian Grona seconded the motion and the committee voted unanimously in approval.

B. Mathematics

Paula Whitman motioned to revise the prerequisites for MATH 1350 Mathematics for Teachers I to read: MATH 1314 with a grade of "C" or better. Paula explained that this mirrors the prerequisite requirements at MSU. Paula included in the motion that the prerequisite for MATH 1351 Mathematics for Teachers II should be: MATH 1350 Mathematics for Teachers I. Marian Grona seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

C. DRAM 2366 Introduction to Cinema

Joe Johnston motioned to add DRAM 2366 Introduction to Cinema to the college's course inventory and also as a selection option in the Core Curriculum in Creative Arts Component Area. Greg Fowler seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
