

Student Success Pathway Task Force Update

The Student Success Pathway Task Force met on February 10, 2017.

Title III Objective

- Retain/persist 68% of VC first-time, full-time credential seeking students who returned or transferred the following Fall; reach a full-time Fall enrollment status (twelve or more credit hours per semester) of 50% of the students; improve first-time/full-time graduation rates to: three (3) year, 30%; four (4) year, 35%; six (6) year 43%; and six (6) year graduation/persistence 53%.

Title III Strategies

1. Provide students, faculty, staff and administration with the information they need to make data informed decisions.
2. Increase academic support through proactive and intrusive advising.

Updates:

- The Student Success Team has been developing and revising the documents used to track efforts. There are two categories of student success efforts: Outreach and Connections.
- Outreach includes emails, phone calls and other efforts to reach students for communication and education purposes.
- Connections refers to actual interactions with students through Academic Coaching, Chap Express, Chap Connections, Student Success Series, STEPS Program, Peer Mentors & Mentees, Faculty Mini Grants, Early Alert Follow-up, etc.
- Example of data: as of 2/15/17 at 4:30 PM there were 1,213 early alerts received; 674 unique students or head count.
