

QEP Development Task Force Update

Joe Johnston and Criquett Lehman met Wednesday, June 15, 2016 to outline the first draft of the response to QEP criteria CR 2.12 and CS 3.3.2. The first draft will focus on Institutional Process specifically these sections of the Quality Enhancement Plan Guidelines rubric 1.A. An institutional **process**, 4.A. Broad-based involvement of institutional constituencies in the ***development of the plan***, 4.B. Broad-based involvement of institutional constituencies in the proposed ***implementation of the plan***.

The QEP Development Task Force Data/Evaluation Plan subgroup met Monday, June 20, 2016 to discuss QEP assessment. Included in the discussion were the pros and cons of using our existing signature assignment process versus a nationally normed instrument, such as the Nelson Denny, as a pre and post assessment. A decision will not be finalized until after the group returns from the Institute on Quality Enhancement and Accreditation in July.
