Data Tracking Examples (to date/in progress)

- Chap Express - 7 Chap Express workshops (4 CCC, 3 VER); Target: 268 (New to VC, TSI incomplete); Actual: 174 participants
- Academic Coaching Outreach - Run weekly Early Alert reports and contact all students who received one or more Early Alert, via email, encouraging them to set an Academic Coaching appointment with a Student Success Specialist (865 students unduplicated; 148 request academic coaching as of Sept 26).
- STEPS Outreach – Probation/suspension students from previous semester enrolled in Fall 2017 (81 students), On-site registration (30 students).
- Student Success Series – Outreach via email to faculty; SS Series: 2 STC, 1 SEY, 6 CCC, 4 VER (13 total); Students: 88 STC/SEY, 146 CCC, 93 VER (327 total)
- Peer Mentor Program – 12 Peer Mentors (1 STC, 6 CCC, 5 VER); 22 CCC Peer Mentees, 3 CCC Peer Mentee Groups, 24 STC Program Peer Mentees, 19 VER Peer Mentees. Average of 6 Peer Mentees per Peer Mentor (Goal=3).
