

Highlights of data:

The Quality Enhancement Resource Inventory (QERI) Survey was administered to faculty and staff in October 2014. 125 respondents completed the survey. The survey was conducted to determine what resources are being used and what training is needed to continue to effectively use educational technology tools.



Employees were asked how often educational technology tools were used to support instruction or job responsibilities. The following are the most used resources based on survey results.

QERI TOP 10

- 1. Cell Phone (Text Messaging)
- 2. Cell Phone (Web Browsing/Apps)
- 3. Presentation Software (e.g., PPT, Prezi)
- **4.** iPad
- 5. Streaming Videos (e.g., YouTube, Helix)
- 6. Digital Camera (including Cell Phone/iPad)
- 7. Audio/Video Clips
- 8. Video Conferencing (e.g., Bb Collaborate, Skype, Facetime)
- 9. Camcorder (including Webcam, Cell Phone, iPad)
- 10. Video Editing Software (e.g., Camtasia)

The question "What has had the most impact on your use of educational technologies at VC?" was posed. In large part, the responses sited availability and training as having the most impact. Those technologies successfully piloted and made available through the QERI and the training and support for these technologies have had the greatest impact on the implementation and continued use at Vernon College.

Use of data:

Scheduled review of educational technology tools made available through the Quality Enhancement Resource Inventory (QERI) is conducted to ensure college-wide input, data analysis, and to identify

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potential areas for improvement. Data is presented to the Technology Committee and the Professional Development Committee for review and planning.
