Highlights of data: This report contains statistical data including demographic data, geographic data, and instructor education data. This ensures compliance with the Board of Nursing requirements (as stated in Rule 214 Texas Administrative Code) for the operation of a Vocational Nursing training program.

The program, inclusive of all three sites, admitted 183 students during Academic year 2014-2015. The completion rate for the program was 43%. Regardless of age, gender, race, or ethnicity the completion rates were similar with approximately one third of each group completing the program. One barrier to completion that was noted was poor time management by the student population. This was a common complaint and seemed to stem from the fact that most students were employed as well as attending the program.

Use of data:

The purpose of this audit is to measure a program's compliance with the Texas Board of Nursing's (BON) rules and regulations governing nursing education in the state of Texas.

How associated to Student Success? This data provides rudimentary knowledge of the numbers of individuals that are admitted versus those who complete the program. The data is then further broken down into sub-categories such as age, gender, race, and ethnicity. The data does show that across the board a student entering our program has less than 50% completion rate. This data is not rigorous enough to glean why student success of completion is limited. It is of note that program completion difficulty seems to be universal and not skewed to one age group, ethnicity, gender or race.
