The total usage of the King Physical Education Center for 2015 was 11,353 visits from students and members. This indicates an approximate 10% increase from 2014 which saw 10,525 visits. The increase can be contributed to the launch of the Silver Sneakers program. Although member and student usage stayed virtually the same and guest visits were slightly down for 2015, the King Center had 800 visits from participants in the Silver Sneaker program.
