**Highlights of data:** This is a Coordinating Board report that shows Faculty salaries, benefits and other departmental expenses by Instructional Program. The most recent completed report is for FYE 08-31-14. The report contains historical cost per SCH, by discipline going back to 1999.

Our average expenditure per FTSE was \$6,703. The average for all 50 CC's was \$6,215 with a low of \$3,899 (Blinn) and a high of \$14,985 (Texas Southmost). We were 33rd out of 57 CC's and Technical Colleges in terms of lowest cost per FTSE.

There is a great deal of comparative data in this report.

**Use of data:** The THECB takes the information from all 50 Community Colleges and calculates these costs on a Contact Hour basis to provide comparison data.

They send a summary report to all CC's for our use in comparing our program costs to the mean average of all CC's or we can do a school by school, program by program comparison. The report is also used by the Legislative Budget Board in determining reimbursement rates for contact hour funding.

**How associated to Student Success?** Helps us evaluate program costs to help with decision whether to expand or eliminate programs so that we are offering the best overall value to our students.
