"I appreciated the tutor coming in after 5:00 p.m." "I have an 85 in Math because of this place." "My grades in math and computers improved once I started coming to the Tutoring Center."

Do you have any suggestions for improving the services of the Tutoring Center?

"Have tutors available more frequently throughout the day." "More hours for Math."

"The only thing I can think of is I wish you were open more hours." "24 hour service, please."

"Bring back tutoring by appointment." "More sign-in computers" "This is the best service offered on campus." "He (the tutor) had not had the professor before and did not know what was expected."

"Wish there were more tutoring for other courses like patho and chemistry." "The tutoring center was my saving grace." "More Nursing tutors and more recordings."

Use of data:

- 1. Continue to email instructors, visit their classes to do orientation, and post notices regarding Tutoring Center services.
- 2. Contact NetTutor to see how we can allow students to evaluate their tutoring sessions.
- 3. Since the Nursing Tutoring hours on NetTutor are very limited, allow the Nursing Department to set up group tutoring for Nursing students.

How associated to Student Success?

Data from 2014-2015 shows that 83% of the students who came in for tutoring within the first 5 weeks of the semester and attended tutoring sessions regularly (9 visits or more) passed their courses for which they were tutored.
