Title: IPEDS Student Financial Aid Survey

Highlights of data:

The purpose of the IPEDS Student Financial Aid component is to collect information about financial aid provided to various groups of undergraduate students. Item areas include:

- Financial aid about all undergraduate students
- Financial aid about all full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking students
- Financial aid and living arrangement information about all full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking students who received grant aid
- Financial aid and living arrangement information about all full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking students who received Title IV aid by income
- Net Price Calculation for full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking students who received grant aid
- Net Price Calculation for full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking students who received Title IV aid by income

Information reported is analyzed and then statistical data is disseminated.

Our groups were as follows:

Group 1 – All undergraduate students – 2,892

Group 2 – Of those in Group 1, those who were full-time, first time degree/certificate seeking – 299

Group 3 – Of those in Group 2, those who paid in-state or in district tuition rate and were awarded grant or scholarship aid from the federal government, state/local government or the institution – 209

Group 4 – Of those in Group 2, those who paid the in-state or in-district tuition rate and were awarded any Title IV federal student aid – 216

Use of data:

The completion of all IPEDS surveys, in a timely and accurate manner is mandatory for all institutions that participate in any Federal financial assistance program authorized by Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended.
