**Title:** Spring 2017 eSIR II Student Instructional Report

**Date of completion:** June 26, 2017

**Highlights of data:**

In April, 2017, 1091 students enrolled in 53 online courses had the opportunity to complete the eSIR II Online Survey. A total of 164 surveys from 25 classes were completed. Students scored each question by marking one of the following: **5**-Very Effective; **4**-Effective; **3**-Moderately Effective; **2**-Somewhat Ineffective; **1**-Ineffective. Results were available online shortly after the survey closed.

**Use of data:**

Spring 2017 online survey participation resulted in forth-seven percent (47%) of the surveyed classes (25 of 53 classes) receiving at least five responses, the minimum necessary to generate a report with fifteen percent (15%) or 164 students participating in the survey process. The results provide detailed information for each instructor/course surveyed. Division Chairs, supervisors, and instructors can use the data to help identify areas of strength and areas where instructors have opportunity for improvement. The comparative data provides data by various categories to assist users in interpreting the report fully.

**How associated to Student Success?**

As instructors improve pedagogically, it is anticipated that student success rates as measured by retention, completion, and transfer rates, will improve.
