Date of completion: 06/28/2017

Highlights of data: There were 2,903 records reported. Out of these records there were 189 waivers based on certificate seeking, 165 waivers based on dual credit, 40 exemptions based on earned degrees, and 14 exemptions based on previous TASP scores.

Use of data: The CBM002 is designed to provide useful data for TSI evaluation. All undergraduate students attempting credit hours at public higher education institutions are required to be reported, including transfer students who are registered for one or more Coordinating Board approved courses during the reporting period. Students in credit certificate programs are included, but students in continuing education programs are excluded. Students who withdraw prior to or on the official census date are not included.
