**Title:** Department of Education 2015-16 FISAP **Date of completion:** September 19, 2017

Highlights of data: Federal regulations state that if the institution spent campus-based program funds (Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant and Federal Work-Study) in 2016-17, the school must submit a Fiscal Operations Report and Application to Participate (FISAP). The report contains two sections: the application to participate in the campus based programs for the 2018-19 year, and a program participation report for 2016-17. Our 2016-17 campus based allocations were: SEOG - \$73,207 and FWS - \$78,740. In addition, the FISAP contained the total Pell expenditures for the 2016-17 year. Our Pell Grant total was \$5,019,325. During the 2016-17 academic year, 1,521 students received Pell Grant (up from 1,509), 108 students received SEOG (up from 92) and 36 students received FWS (no change).

**Use of data:** The law states that if the Department of Education (ED) does not receive a completed application by October 1 each year, the school cannot be assured a campus based allocation for the upcoming academic year. Our report was submitted September 21. ED uses the information provided to determine the amount of funds VC will receive for each campus based program in the following academic year. Tentative 2018-19 campus based allocations will be announced by February 1, 2018. Final allocations will be announced by March 31, 2018.

**How associated to Student Success?** Many students would not be able to enroll in VC without the services and assistance provided to them by the financial aid office.
