Title: eSIR II Supplementary Questions (Spring 2019) Date of completion: August 8, 2019

Highlights of data:

In August 2019, 798 students enrolled in 36 online courses had the opportunity to complete the eSIR II Online Survey. 158 surveys from 22 online classes met the minimum of 5 surveys required to receive a report. An additional 53 surveys from 19 classes were completed but failed to meet the minimum of 5 surveys per class to receive a report.

<u>Ten institutional-option questions</u> were added to the survey relating specifically to student's experiences at Vernon College. Students scored each question by marking one of the following: <u>5-Very Effective</u>; <u>4-Effective</u>; <u>3-Moderately Effective</u>; <u>2 Somewhat Ineffective</u>; <u>1-Ineffective</u>; <u>0-Not</u>
