Title: Report 1

Date of completion: April 8, 2019

Highlights of data: The FADB Progress Report provides information on all merit, need based and non-need based financial aid recipients for the 2018-19 year. The data includes cost of attendance and the resources used by students to cover that cost, and includes the amounts and types of financial aid received by students. Institutions are required to submit a comprehensive FADB Report three times a year to consolidate data collection. Two reports will require a validation of data and the final report will require a certification. Our 2018-19 FADB Progress Report 1 reported information on 3,016 students. The deadline to validate the report was April 15. Our report was validated April 8.

Use of data: The purpose of the Financial Aid Database (FAD) Report is to collect data used by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) to produce an annual statewide Financial Aid Report, determine state aid program allocations, conduct compliance monitoring, and generate additional statewide and institutional reports. The FAD Report provides the state with a means of measuring and analyzing the funding resources available to students attending public and private/independent institutions of higher education in Texas.

How associated to Student Success? Many students would not be able to enroll in VC without the services and assistance provided to them by the financial aid office.
