Title: ESCR Data Spring 2019

Date of completion: July 2019

Highlights of data: The benchmark for student achievement of core objectives at Vernon College is set at 75%. Instructors reported attainment over 75% for all but two of the six core objectives. The core objectives of Empirical/Quantitative and Teamwork showed attainment of 71.4% and 70.4%.

Use of data: Instructor professional development and curricular changes at the department and course level are driven by the instructors' reflections and reported attainment when completing the ESCR. Instructors completed 89 unique ESCRs during Spring 2019.

How associated to Student Success? Using core objective attainment level and grade distributions, instructors reflect on student success across all six core objectives and course level learning outcomes. Individual reflection and departmental discussion act as catalysts for curricular changes at the course level and increased student success on objectives.
