Highlights of data:

85 unduplicated ADA students served in 2017-2018

DISABILITIES: 34 Learning Disabled- 40% ; 23 ADD/ADHD-27%; 12 Psychiatric- 14%; 11 Autistic-13%; 10 Physical- 12% Deaf /HOH-8%; 6 Dyslexic-7%; 4 Blind/Visually Impaired-5%;

ACCOMMODATIONS: 62 Extended testing time-73%; 40 Quiet testing; 47% 31 Other Requests-36%; (Priority seating; Interpreter; CART services; Live Scribe Pen provided by TWC; Handouts in Advance; Colored or Dark Glasses, etc.) 20 Digital Recorder-24%; 15 Requested tutoring-18%; 10 Oral Testing-12%; 7 Note taker-8%;

SUCCESS RATES:

437 total classes taken by the accommodated students

336 classes completed with an A, B, C, CP, or P grade

77% overall completion rate

Use of data:

1. Continue to monitor physical facilities to ensure adequate space for extended testing and quiet testing accommodations.
2. Continue to encourage all ADA students to participate in tutoring.
3. Based on assessment results, the completion rate for 2018-2019 was raised from 67% to 70%.
