**Title:** New Beginnings Evaluation

**Date of completion:** July 12, 2018

**Highlights of data:** 176 of 274 participants (64%) of New Beginnings participants completed a tutoring services evaluation. Using only the applicable answers, here are the results:

100%- YES-“Were you able to focus more effectively on your courses knowing your children were in a safe, licensed child care facility?”

99%-YES-“Did New Beginnings services help you achieve your educational goals?”

98%-“YES-“Was the method of book distribution and returns efficient?”

98% YES-Was the New Beginnings Staff available when you needed them?”

Some comments:

“Thank you for helping me succeed.” “I was able to go to school because of this program. I am forever grateful!” “Very helpful to have assistance with child care! Would not be able to afford school otherwise.”

**Use of data:** Based on assessment results, the satisfaction rate will remain at 85%. The Director and Coordinator will continue to monitor services to ensure student satisfaction with all New Beginnings services.

**How associated to Student Success?** The New Beginnings Program helps to eliminate barriers for single parents and economically disadvantaged students who are at risk for not completing due to financial problems, lack of child care, or transportation issues. These services allow the student to focus on their studies instead of worrying about how to pay for books, child care, etc.
