Title: 2016-2018 New Beginnings Fact Sheet

Date of completion: 10/31/2019

Highlights of data: Graduates increased by 31.5 % from 2017 to 2018.
Participants decreased by 12%
Caucasian participants decreased by 2%.
Gasoline reimbursement services increased by 2%
The program placement rate for the past year was 93%
The cumulative placement rate was 97%.
Student participants loans and grants were up 2%
The Student participant rate for applying for a PELL Grant remained 100%
Student participants who received a PELL Grant dropped 5% to 70%

Use of data: 2017-2018 was an unusual year. Participants were down due to the LVN Program not starting until the Spring Semester. Fewer students received a PELL Grant in 2017-2018. Staff will continue to monitor PELL Grant applicants and recipients.

How associated to Student Success? This program has consistently maintained a high 90's placement rate, and has consistently increased its graduate numbers. This is a part of the data set used to determine student success at Vernon College and at the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board.
