| Highlights of data: All 4 sports teams as well as Athletic Training required students to complete grade reports for each class. A total of 103 students over 5 programs. Each student athlete has approximately 5 classes. Of the approximately 515 class grades there were 13 that were unsatisfactory. Coaches each used their own team policies to help intervene so that students can raise those unsatisfactory grades. These interventions included: increased study halls, assigning a peer mentor to students, removal of travel privileges, additional tutoring through the PASS center, and shortened curfew. | | | | | |
