Highlights of data:

All 4 Athletic Teams required each student athlete to get progress reports for each class.

- Baseball – 39 players, 14 players reported an unsatisfactory grade of D or F, study hall requirements were increased for those 14 players and the head coach met with those 14 players to stress the importance of academics
- Rodeo – 22 athletes, 3 students reported an unsatisfactory grade of D or F, the coach met individually with each student and then required each student to meet individually with the instructor who's class they were doing poorly in
- Softball – 20 players, 7 players reported an unsatisfactory grade of D or F, all 7 players were required to attend extra study hall hours and were given an earlier curfew, they also met with the coach and were required to meet with their instructors, 2 students had to withdraw from their class
- Volleyball- 12 athletes, 4 players reported unsatisfactory grades of D, they met with the coach about these courses and are receiving extra tutoring, the coach will require follow up progress reports from these 4 students the first week of April

Use of data:

This process helps athletics to focus on the importance of academics and helps students remember their roles as students even during a busy season. It also emphasizes the importance of academics to very busy student athletes and helps coaches to implement early intervention measures.
