Highlights of data: The CBM 116 Follow-up Report provides institutions with the opportunity to report graduate placement (attending a college or university, employed, self-employed, military or other such as deceased and incarcerated) for previous students not found through the THECB processes. The Vernon College report included 19 majors and 71 graduates. Through the hard work of faculty and staff, 56 of the 71 were located. Forty-five met the placement definition which significantly helped to increase placement rates. A complete aggregated report has been requested from the THECB.

Use of data: This data is part of the Perkins Data Resources information used for funding requests. It should be noted that the CBM 116 report includes General Studies; however, the Perkins Data Resources does not include General Studies.
