

Highlights of data:

The Community College Faculty Survey of Student Engagement, designed as a companion survey to CCSSE, elicits information from faculty about their perceptions regarding students' educational experiences, their teaching practices, and the ways they spend their professional time—both in and out of the classroom.

Example of data: full- and part-time faculty members' perceptions of three in-class student experiences.



Use of data:

Statement of need and assessment are two of the required components in the Vernon College annual planning process. CCFSSE data is commonly referred to as a potential data source for decision making in the areas of facilities, institutional improvement, personnel, and technology. Scheduled review of CCFSSE data is conducted to ensure college-wide awareness of results and to identify potential areas for improvement.

Data was presented to multiple representatives of each component of the college. The data is also made available to all employees through Blackboard (Quality Enhancement Course) and the CCFSSE website at www.ccsse.org/ccfsse.

How associated to Student Success?

The survey, administered to community college faculty, asks questions that assess institutional practices and student behaviors that are correlated highly with student learning and student retention. It is used in conjunction with the CCSSE.
