



This monthly report is intended to provide the Vernon College Board of Trustees, Vernon College Foundation Board members, as well as college faculty and staff, with updated information regarding significant college activities, issues, and accomplishments.

College Governance - Dr. Dusty R. Johnston

- The Board of Trustees conducted the annual board retreat as well as the regular monthly meeting on July 20 at the conference room at Skills Training Center in Wichita Falls. The retreat agenda included discussion in regard to business office position realignment caused by the elimination of the Associate Dean of Administrative Services position formerly held by Bob Bolton, a thorough review and explanation of the monthly financial report to provide additional information for board members, and a brief discussion of future plans and efforts of the Vernon College Foundation. Primary discussions during the regular meeting included the third draft of the 2011-2012 budget and information about the tax appraisal and tax rate for the upcoming year.
- In addition to the meetings, Vernon College hosted a luncheon inviting our Midwestern State University parties for food and fellowship since the meeting was in Wichita Falls. The group included MSU administration and board members including Dr. Jessie Rogers. Also included were Vernon College board members, administrators, and Vernon College Foundation board members. After lunch, the group was given a tour of the recently renovated Skills Training Center.
- Vicki Pennington, Todd Smith, and Dr. Johnston attended the Governance Institute for Student Success recently.
 The focus of the institute was to provide trustees and presidents the opportunity for time and information to work together to develop an institutional agenda to achieve the needed increases in student attainment and completion.
 It was a very informative conference which provided a large number of ideas and practices to consider which can enhance student success.
- The administrative team has accomplished a final review of the 2011-2012 budget. The budget will be recommended to the board for approval at the regular meeting on August 17. The effective tax rate will also be recommended. The effective rate calculates to be .2234/\$100 as compared to last year's rate of .2267/\$100. Although, Vernon College absorbed just over \$1million for group insurance and employee retirement funding that was lost in the last legislative session, the recommended budget is a good budget balanced with budget reductions and increases in tuition and fee revenues.
- The bid specifications for the renovation at Century City Center continue to be finalized. The bids are expected to be finalized in September so renovation can be started in October. The price of such extreme progress at CCC may be some noise and other disruptions. The contractors will be as careful as possible, but the demolish stage must happen early on so the project can move forward.


