- The Vernon College Board of Trustees held board retreat on July 18, conducted by Dr. Raymond Hawkins. The primary purpose of the retreat was to discuss the roles and responsibilities of community college board members to assist in meeting the mission of the college. The board meeting conducted after the retreat included issuance of employee contracts for 2012-2013 which included approval of a 3% salary increase and a good discussion of the 2012-2013 proposed budget. The board also approved the purchase of a large amount of fitness equipment from the former Gold's' Gym to assist with future plans to operate the fitness center primarily for academic classes, student use, employee use, and community use. These plans have not been finalized at this time.
- The Century City Center Open House on July 26 was a great success. An estimate of over 300 community people and employees attended the event. Many people took advantage of the opportunity to tour the facility and all comments were extremely positive.
