

# June 2013 Update

This monthly report is intended to provide the Vernon College Board of Trustees, Vernon College Foundation Board members, as well as college faculty and staff, with updated information regarding significant college activities, issues, and accomplishments.

## College Governance - Dr. Dusty R. Johnston

- The regular session of the Legislature has ended and now a special session is in progress. The current state of appropriations is good for Texas community colleges and we do not expect that to change during the special session. Primary accomplishments for community colleges were:
  - Approval of a three prong approach to instructional funding
    - \$500,000 per year for core operations for each college district
    - 10% of remaining appropriations distributed based upon performance measures
    - 90% of remaining appropriations distributed based upon contact hours
  - A 50-50 cost sharing agreement between the state and community colleges for the funding of group health insurance and retirement costs approved and codified
  - Elimination of the every year redistribution of funds based on contact hours ( the attempt to redistribute funds in this manner was considered a failure by all)
  - A two percent increase in total funding for Texas community colleges
- The administrative team is working to finalize second draft of the 2013-2014 budget to be discussed at the June 19 board meeting. The second draft will include additional funding for basic state appropriations, group health insurance, and retirement.
- The Vernon College board of trustees approved the 2013-2014 Annual Action Plan at the May 15 meeting. This is a very good plan that each department should work hard to accomplish during the next year.
- The Security/Safety Task Force has met several times and is finalizing many recommendations for improvement. A significant recommendation will be for implementation of a mass notification system to notify students, employees, and others of emergency events via text, e-mail, Facebook, and Twitter.
- Renovation continues at Century City Center with the demolition of the old entryways. The new entryway will be complete prior to the beginning of the fall semester.
- The renewed, improved Fitness Center at CCC is going very well. Please take the time to visit the Fitness Center and take advantage of what it has to offer employees as well as students.
- All departments are preparing for the fall semester. Everyone should take every opportunity to recruit and to market for Vernon College. Enrollment drives many things for a community college and I am looking forward to a strong fall enrollment.

## Instruction - Dr. Gary Don Harkey

- Congratulations to **Paula Whitman** (Mathematics Instructor) for being named a recipient of the 2013 Dr. William Leroy Estes Excellence and Innovation Award!
- Summer I and Summer 11 classes are underway while registration for the Summer II term will continue through July 9. Currently there 2860 enrollments for all summer terms combined as compared to 2774 total enrollments last summer.
- Early College Start Coordinator **Jessica Sutherland** concluded her <u>Spring Forward</u> presentations this past month with high school visits to Quanah and Windthorst. In summation, Jessica presented dual credit information at 24 service area high schools with total attendance of potential dual credit students numbering 583 along with 214 parents for a total attendance of over 800 people at the 2013 <u>Spring Forward</u> presentations.
- The **Surgical Technology Program** under the direction of Program Coordinator & Instructor **Jeff Feix**, was recently recognized (for the 11<sup>th</sup> consecutive year) as an *AST GALAXY STAR PROGRAM* at the National AST Conference in New Orleans. The AST Galaxy is a program to recognize surgical technology programs (Stars) that promote their students' future success in the field by encouraging membership in their national professional organization—The Association of Surgical Technologists. Galaxy Stars receive special recognition at the national conference, in the *Surgical Technologist Journal*, and in the *Instructors Newsletter*.
- Cosmetology Instructor **Diana Shipley** recently attended a teacher training in Dallas sponsored by the International Congress of Esthetics.

• Data Update: A link to the Workforce, Academic Affairs and Research Division's Existing Program Performance Review System has been added to the Texas Higher Education Data website under Online Applications. <u>http://www.txhighereddata.org/</u>

This information is used for the periodic review of the performance of existing degree programs, aligns with the THECB's task of outcome-based assessment, and provides institutions with information to assist in program improvement. Reports can be run for specific Vernon College programs as well as peer group and statewide comparisons.

The information includes annual snapshots and cohort data such as Fall Enrollment (full/part time), Awards, Persistence Rate, Licensure Pass Rate, Graduation Rate, Placement Rate, and Time to Degree.
