

May 2012 Update

This monthly report is intended to provide the Vernon College Board of Trustees, Vernon College Foundation Board members, as well as college faculty and staff, with updated information regarding significant college activities, issues, and accomplishments.

College Governance – Dr. Dusty R. Johnston

- The renovations at the Century City Center in Wichita Falls are progressing at a very rapid pace. Deans and other staff are making plans to move into Phase I (student services, admissions, financial aid, business office, bookstore, library, police, advising center, and special services) after graduation in May. Phase II (two story allied health area) should be available for relocation in June, and Phase III (continuing education, classrooms, and offices in currently used area) should be available for relocation in July. At the April meeting, the board approved purchasing up to \$300,000 of furnishings for the renovated area. Most furnishings for Phase I have been ordered and discussions with vendors for furnishings for Phase III and Phase III are near completion.
- The first draft of the 2012-2013 budget was presented and discussed at the April board meeting. The administrative team is currently working on draft two which will be presented and discussed at the May board meeting. The budget will continue to be discussed and revised during the summer and the board will approve the final budget at the August 15 board meeting. A key element of the budget is on hold until the College receives the final update on state funding changes that may result from the funding being reallocated for the second year of the biennium based on contact hours generated in the first year of the biennium. That data is expected by the end of May. In the first draft of the budget, the primary revenue increases are from increases in tuition and fee enrollment based on this year's actual enrollment increase as well as the modest increases in tuition and fees approved in the March meeting. The primary increases in expenses are related to:
 - Increase in operational cost at CCC including
 - Increased utilities
 - Supplies
 - Part-time bookstore clerk
 - Four additional custodial positions due to renovation/expansion
 - Increase in instructional cost including five and one-half additional instructional positions
 - Biology @CCC
 - Developmental Math/Computer Instructor @Vernon
 - Music/Fine Arts position
 - Interpreter working at both CCC and Vernon
 - ¹/₂ Emergency Medical Services
 - Faculty support secretary for non-Nursing Allied Health programs
 - Increase in institutional support/student services
 - Admissions clerk @CCC
 - Financial Aid clerk @ CCC
 - Continuing the website position after transition of IT
 - Continuing the POISE position after transition of IT
 - Increase in contingency for the unexpected
 - 3.0% increase in salary for faculty and staff

Each of the above costs and positions are subject to change as the state funding picture becomes final and review by administration and the board of trustees continues.

• The Vernon College board of trustee election is currently taking place for early voting. The official election date is May 12, 2012. There are two contested positions in the election and one uncontested position (Bob Ferguson). The newly elected board members will be qualified at the May 16 board meeting and will begin service immediately.
