

# May 2014 Update

This monthly report is intended to provide the Vernon College Board of Trustees, Vernon College Foundation Board members, as well as college faculty and staff, with updated information regarding significant college activities, issues, and accomplishments.

# College Governance - Dr. Dusty R. Johnston

- The annual planning process has gone very well this spring. A summary of the 2014-2015 plan will be presented to the board of trustees for approval on May 21.
- The plan drives the budgeting process which is currently in process. The first draft of the budget was presented to the board of trustees on April 16 for discussion. Draft one included most expenditure requests from departments and components of the College as well as estimated revenue. The budget is a long way from being balanced (approximately \$500,000), so a lot of work is taking place to develop draft two which includes expenditure reductions throughout the college as well as analyzing all revenue estimates. Draft two will be reviewed by the board of trustees at the May meeting and much of the July board retreat is dedicated to finalizing the budget. The budget is approved at the August board meeting.
- Progress is being made on several of the Employee Friendly Task Force recommendations. Bids are being taken to add additional lighting for the CCC parking lot and discussions are being conducted to develop designated employee parking at the CCC facility to begin August 1. The following clarifications have been provided in regard to some of the additional recommendations:
  - The intent of the current comp time policy is to keep comp time at a minimum in all departments of the college. The intent is to also have the comp time utilized as soon as possible which is in compliance with federal law and policy and therefore it needs to be taken prior to vacation time. In rare cases where someone may lose vacation time, Dr. Johnston will be glad to be involved in the discussion with the employee and HR to find a solution.
  - O While the College certainly encourages participation in various civic organizations, the College is not prepared to pay civic club dues for all employees. The College pays a very limited number of civic club dues for positions that are expected to engage with the public because of position to promote the college. At this time, the paying of civic club dues is limited to President, Deans, Associate Deans, as well as business and industry related and/or marketing related positions approved by the supervisor and by the president.
  - o In regard to specialized training not provided via in house CE—if the training is directly related to improving skills for the employee's current job, the supervising Dean has the authority to approve the use of professional development funds for such training. The College is not responsible for licensure and/or certification costs that are a basic qualification for a position such as nursing licensure, HVAC licensure, etc.
- The Administrative Staff Association made a recommendation to the president to increase meal reimbursement rates during college related travel due to cost at many conference locations. After careful consideration, the following meal reimbursement rates will be recommended to the board of trustees in the June meeting. Once approved the new rates will take place with the new budget year beginning September 1.
  - o Day travel/no overnight stay
