

September 2015 Update

This monthly report is intended to provide the Vernon College Board of Trustees, Vernon College Foundation Board members, as well as college faculty and staff, with updated information regarding significant college activities, issues, and accomplishments.

College Governance - Dr. Dusty R. Johnston

- The Vernon College Board of Trustees approved the proposed 2015-2016 budget at the August 19 meeting. The budget totaled \$21,690,397 which was \$329,551 less than the previous year's budget. The board also approved to propose a tax rate of .2200/\$100 for the upcoming budget year. This rate is slightly more than the effective rate but less than the rollback rate. Public hearings for the proposed tax rate were set for September 1 and September 8. The proposed tax rate will be approved at the September 16 board meeting.
- There has been a tremendous amount of national discussion about college and university sexual assault policies and practices the past two years. In response, a small task force was formed this summer to evaluate current Vernon College policies, procedures, process, and practices specifically developed to handle alleged sexual assaults and/or any other student initiated sexual harassment complaint. John Hardin, with help from all in his department and Haven David, reviewed current policies, procedures, processes, and practices to be sure Vernon College meets current Title IX expectations. The review included:
 - O How policy/practice information is disseminated? Is it specifically discussed in NSO, Residence Hall orientation, athletic team meetings? If so, is this documented?
 - o What immediate services are made available to an alleged victim of sexual assault?
 - What is the detailed process for follow-up to an alleged assault?
 - What specifically initiates a decision to include local authorities?
 - Where is documentation of complaints, process, and decisions, kept?

The group did a very good job and the recommended updated sexual assault policies and procedures were approved by the board on August 19. I encourage you to review the updated policy on the Vernon College website or contact the Dean of Students office for information.

- The fall kick-off for all employees on August 17 was a very good and informational event. A highlight is always the service awards presentation. Vernon College is fortunate to have dedicated and loyal employees.
- Fall semester enrollment is currently at 2922 students which is 2.5% less than the 2995 reported on the 12th class day last fall. This enrollment decline continues to be a statewide trend, but we need to continue all efforts to stabilize and/or increase enrollment at Vernon College. I appreciate the many efforts of everyone including the Integrated Marketing/Recruiting committee for initiating a number of efforts.
- I am serving my third and final term as a member of the THECB Funding Formula Advisory Committee. I have been selected as chair of the Community and Technical Colleges sub-committee. We will work via e-mail and telephone as well as participate in four meetings this fall to assist the Coordinating Board in developing its' funding recommendation for the next legislative session. I am open to any ideas you would like to share that might impact the future recommendations.

<u>Instruction – Dr. Gary Don Harkey</u>

- Volleyball has begun the season with a 4-0 undefeated record after sweeping their Vernon College tournament on August 28 and 29. Please come out and support our team at any of our future games your cheers help! Volleyball currently has 19 players on the roster.

- Softball currently has 25 athletes on their roster and are playing scrimmages to evaluate new talent.
