

May 2017 Update

This monthly report is intended to provide the Vernon College Board of Trustees, Vernon College Foundation Board members, as well as college faculty and staff, with updated information regarding significant college activities, issues, and accomplishments.

College Governance - Dr. Dusty R. Johnston

- All initial 2017-2018 budget requests were turned in by April 1. The administrative team worked hard to prepare the first draft of the budget. It appears, at this time, that state appropriations for the next biennium will decrease approximately \$200,000 each year. We are taking a very conservative approach to estimated tuition and fee revenue and expect there will be increases in health insurance cost of approximately \$100,000. The 1.5% step increase in salary schedules will impact the budget approximately \$150,000. Expenses exceed revenue in draft 1 of the 2017-2018 budget by over \$500,000 so there are still numerous decisions to be made over the next few months to balance the budget.
- The board of trustees approved the updated Strategic Plan and the Annual Action Plan as well as the Concealed Carry on Campus policy. All are available on the Vernon College website.
- There has been considerable discussion regarding enhancing police/security/safety at Vernon College locations. The proposal includes increasing licensed police officer positions as well as hiring security personnel as college employees to be trained and supervised by Vernon College personnel. This should enhance scheduling of positions at various locations and ensure consistency of training and understanding of job duties and functions.
- As the semester nears end, several sports teams have concluded their seasons. Hunter Koch (Vernon resident) and Blake Glenn (Walters, OK) qualified for the College National Finals Rodeo in team roping. Chad Smith was voted Rodeo Coach of the Year in the Southwest Region. The softball team and the baseball team have completed their seasons. The softball team made a strong run to qualify for the regional tournament, but came up a couple of wins short. LaShaunda Spurgeon has been named the Vernon College head volleyball coach.
