

# June 2021 Update

This monthly report is intended to provide the Vernon College Board of Trustees, Vernon College Foundation Board members, as well as college faculty and staff, with updated information regarding significant college activities, issues, and accomplishments.

### College Governance - Dr. Dusty R. Johnston, President

- The administrative team has worked hard on draft two of the 2021-2022 budget. Several expenses have been reduced or eliminated and other changes have been implemented. We have estimated 7.5% reduction in tuition and fee revenue as enrollment is hard to estimate for next year. Even though we have reduced expenditures over \$500,000, draft two still has over \$200,000 more of expenses than revenue at this time. We are continuing to look for additional expenditure reductions and will review all revenue estimates. Draft two tax revenue is based upon the estimated effective "no new taxes" rate. Draft two includes the following expectations:
  - o Conservative estimate of tuition and fee revenue
  - o 1.5% salary schedule step increase in compensation for all employees
  - o 1 new van
  - o 1 new grant writing position
  - o 1 new student success specialist position to support mandatory advising (funds reallocated from one retirement and one internal transfer)
  - o Increase in the number of paid faculty advisors (5 to 10)
  - o Increase in faculty professional development travel
  - Increase in instructional technology
  - Increase in distance learning technology
  - o Increase in nursing testing budget to be more accurate
  - Increase in information technology equipment
    - > Some of the above will be possible due to reallocated HEERF funds claimed for "lost revenue" due to the impact of COVID-19 disruption
- A topic of discussion has been continuation of the Vernon on-campus limited-hours health clinic for students and employees. The clinic has been in operation for several years, but the current doctor who provides oversight to the clinic is retiring. The College will begin finding a replacement so the clinic can continue operation.

- Vernon College **Surgical Technology Program** featured in the PeriopSimVR April Newsletter, for implementation of Virtual Reality software for student lab training and pre-clinical experience.
- **Phi Theta Kappa** raised over \$4,000 for Peers Against Tobacco Initiative. This is the seventh year participating in this program that is funded by the University of Texas.
- **Phi Theta Kappa** provided funds for the "Hungry Hearts" food drive for K-12 Archer City to have meals in the summer.
- **Phi Theta Kappa**, in conjunction with Assent realty, donated \$16,500 to Haynes Elementary School to purchase a new playground, a plan is under way to provide the same assistance to Lamar Elementary School.
