

September 2021 Update

This monthly report is intended to provide the Vernon College Board of Trustees, Vernon College Foundation Board members, as well as college faculty and staff, with updated information regarding significant college activities, issues, and accomplishments.

College Governance - Dr. Dusty R. Johnston, President

- The Vernon College Board of Trustees approved the proposed 2021-2022 budget totaling \$21,972,591. The proposed budget had undergone tremendous scrutiny the past several months. The approved budget is based on state revenue, tuition/fee revenue, and tax revenue based on the no new revenue tax rate (formerly called the effective rate). The budget includes a very conservative estimate of tuition and fee revenue based on the 19-20 actual enrollment numbers and a 5% reduction in case of enrollment decline due to COVID-19 as well as a 5% reduction in local tax collection. The budget includes a 3.0% salary schedule step increase for all employees.
- The Vernon College Board of Trustees conducted a public meeting which included a discussion of tax rates on July 14, 2021 and August 11 Based upon the WCAD certified appraisal data the no new revenue tax rate (formerly called the effective rate) for 2021 will be 24.8389 cents per \$100 of appraised property value. This is a slight increase from the previous year tax rate of 23.2436 cents per \$100 of appraised property value. Due to changes made in the 2019 legislative session, discussion occurred in the August meeting that the action item to set the proposed no new revenue rate will be on the September board agenda.
- The Vernon College Board of Trustees approved the Osborne building roof repair completion. Due to cost, the College repaired 2/3 of the roof on the Osborne building last year. This repair will complete the project. Parson's Roofing is a state approved vendor for school and state agencies roof repair so using them does not require a bid process. They are well respected in the state. The quoted cost to repair/cover the Osborne building roof is \$75,518.00 which will include:
 - o Install ½" Polystyrene insulation over existing roofing
 - o Fasten a white 50-mil Duro-Last roof with a 15-year NDL warranty.
 - Additional Parson's Roofing 10-year warranty
 - o Install all flashings, encapsulate all parapet walls and install 24 gauge prefinished fascia bar at roof perimeter.
- Vernon College published a Request for Proposals on August 4, 2021 for a new Enterprise Resource Program/Student Information System (ERP/SIS). The decision to choose the vendor should be made by the end of October and the project starts in January 2022. Implementation is estimated to take eighteen months.
- Total enrollment is currently 2364 students as compared to final enrollment last fall of 2786. Many variables have influenced community college enrollment this fall in Texas and across the nation. More statewide information will be available soon. I appreciate work to initiate a number of efforts to improve registration processes and enrollment.
- The COVID-19 related signage is being revised and placed at all campus locations to encourage vaccination, wearing of masks, and social distancing.
