

June 2023 Update

This monthly report is intended to provide the Vernon College Board of Trustees, Vernon College Foundation Board members, as well as college faculty and staff, with updated information regarding significant college activities, issues, and accomplishments.

College Governance - Dr. Dusty R. Johnston, President

- In the May 10 meeting, the Vernon College Board of Trustees approved:
 - ° 2023-2024 Annual Plan--The planning process continues to improve and strengthen the institution. The process has continued to be enhanced with input from board members, faculty, and staff. The planning process has produced an annual action plan for 2023-2024. All employees have been strongly encouraged to participate in the process. The College Effectiveness committee has met monthly to monitor assessment activities and to promote the planning process. Dr. Brad Beauchamp gave the board an update/review of the planning process. The planning process produced a Technology Plan, a Personnel Plan, a Facility Plan, and an Institutional Improvement Plan. All of these combined produced the Annual Action Plan. Each is important as we budget for future needs of the College.
 - ° 2023 Kids College Schedule—this is usually approved at the same time as the Summer Continuing Education schedule in April. It was not quite ready at last month's meeting. It is now ready for approval an included in you Canvas board agenda information.
 - ° 2023-2024 College Catalog— College staff have revised and updated the college catalog to include any changes previously approved by the board such as tuition and fee charges. Also updated are any policies, procedures, or guidelines that may have needed additional clarification. The various calendars and employee sections have also been updated.
- 2023-2024 Budget—the administrative team has worked hard on draft two of the 2023-2024 budget. Several expenses have been reduced or eliminated and other changes have been implemented. The tuition and fee estimated revenue is based upon 2022-2023 actual tuition and fee revenue since enrollment is unpredictable. Draft two is still a not balanced as we have not increased state funding, but we do expect additional state funding because of the new funding methodology. We should know state funding numbers by the time we finalize draft three. We are continuing to look for additional expenditure reductions and will review all revenue estimates. Draft two tax revenue is based upon the estimated effective "no new taxes" rate. Draft two now includes the following expectations:
 - ° Conservative estimate of tuition and fee revenue
 - ° 3.0% salary schedule step increase in compensation for all employees
 - \$500,000 from savings/reserve to pay toward the Ellucian/Colleague cost
