Based on a review of the 2011-2012 Faculty Load & Listing, 71.6% of the faculty load was borne by full time instructors. According to the reports provided to the THECB, 68.7% of the contact hours at Vernon College were taught by full-time faculty in Fall 2011.

Use of data:

Full-time : Part-time faculty ratios within programs and disciplines are utilized to prioritize needs for additional full-time faculty members.

How associated to Student Success?

The hiring of the additional full-time faculty in 2011-2012 increased the overall knowledge base and provided additional areas of expertise within subject matters which benefits the institution and enhances student learning. The additional full-time faculty enabled the institution to schedule additional course offerings in three subject areas (English, History, Culinary Arts) and increase the number of course sections being offered.
