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## Highlights of data:

In November, 2012, 4470 students enrolled in 229 face-to-face courses had the opportunity to complete the SIR II Survey.

Students scored each question by marking one of the following: <u>5-Very Effective</u>; <u>4-Effective</u>; <u>3-Moderately</u> <u>Effective</u>; <u>2-Somewhat Ineffective</u>; <u>1-Ineffective</u>. A batch summary report and a data disk containing individual survey results arrived in January 2013. Results for the face-to-face courses are listed below.

The results retrieved detailed information for each instructor surveyed. Division Chairs, supervisors, and instructors can use the data to help identify areas of strength and areas where instructors have opportunity for improvement. The comparative data provides data by various categories to assist users in interpreting the report fully. For example, a 3.6 is numerically above average on a 5-point scale, but it may be average or even slightly below average in comparison to other means for items in SIR II.

## How associated to Student Success?

As instructors improve pedagogically, it is anticipated that student success rates as measured by retention, completion, and transfer rates, will improve.
