Highlights of data:

In November, 2012, 1118 students enrolled in 58 online courses had the opportunity to complete the eSIR II Online Survey.

Students scored each question by marking one of the following: **5**-Very Effective; **4**-Effective; **3**-Moderately Effective; **2**-Somewhat Ineffective; **1**-Ineffective. Results were available online shortly after the survey closed.

Use of data:

Fall 2012 online survey participation improved over previous semesters. Seventy-six percent (44) of the surveyed classes received at least five responses, the minimum necessary to generate a report. However, only 31.8% (355) of the students enrolled in online classes being surveyed participated in the survey process. The results retrieved detailed information for each instructor/course surveyed. Division Chairs, supervisors, and instructors can use the data to help identify areas of strength and areas where instructors have opportunity for improvement. The comparative data provides data by various categories to assist users in interpreting the report fully.

How associated to Student Success?

As instructors improve pedagogically, it is anticipated that student success rates as measured by retention, completion, and transfer rates, will improve.
