The Housing Inventory Report shows two fully stocked on campus Residence Halls consisting of a total of 74 rooms for student use. The report also includes surplus items including mattress covers and shower curtains.

These items are ordered and installed for Fall 2012 move —in that occurs in August 2012. Replacement items this year will include 20 new mattresses, 4 new bedframes, and 4 chairs.
