- Financial aid about all undergraduate students
- Financial aid about all full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking students
- Financial aid and living arrangement information about all full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking students who received grant aid
- Financial aid and living arrangement information about all full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking students who received Title IV aid by income
- Net Price Calculation for full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking students who received grant aid
- Net Price Calculation for full-time, first-time degree/certificate-seeking students who received Title IV aid by income

Information reported is analyzed and then statistical data is disseminated.

**Use of data:** The completion of all IPEDS surveys, in a timely and accurate manner is mandatory for all institutions that participate in any Federal financial assistance program authorized by Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended.

**How associated to Student Success?** If an institution fails to submit their IPEDS report, their eligibility as a Title IV institution could be suspended.
